

Tami Stainfield Arrest on April 20, 2013 – Professionalism of Officers and Arrest procedures– furthermore Constitutional legality of the definitions.

Left home Saturday late morning said hello to young child and older man on porch next to 1561 Dixie Street – have nice day and play some games. Drove by the Sheriff's Department ready to turn right onto Kanawha Road.

After complete stop at Goshorn/Kanawha Stop Sign Sheriff Vehicles stops behind me (Officer 1). Ready to turn right – announcement in car “Tami if you hear this go to cop behind you and tell him this is rafty (raffia raga?) Network”

I open car door and about 10 ft. from Sheriff's car in calm and pleasant manner – facial expression please would like to speak to you – Officer 1 opened window only 1/3 down – I repeated “they said to tell you that this is rafty (raffia, raga?) network” his face changed and got upset – yet I said “I don't know where it came from United, your cop car, that building or this building” I used my arm to show point to buildings. No purse or any items on me except cloths. He was upset – didn't care – he knew network (?) I Tami don't - I turned and walk away. That was end of conversation with Officer 1/he never left car.

2 ft. from my car door and 15 ft. from Officer 1; I said in so many words “can't fucking believe this” then I heard noise from Officer 1 however I didn't hear what he said for I was distance from his car and his window was 1/3 down. As I started to get into my car; about 2ft from door I turned and at end of street another cop (officer 2); he had been watching he lifted his left arm (gun stance or directions). Officer 2 location was close to other Stop Sign Virginia St. opposite Officer 1 location at Stop Sign on Kanawha St; Officer 2 was on left side 8 ft. from sidewalk where Sheriff Dept. park their vehicles.

As I got in car siren went off behind me; and within seconds another siren Officer 2 lights went off. I had only one option turned right on Kanawha and then immediately turned onto Truslow where I parked my vehicle completely on the right hand sidewalk and off the street.

Two cops pulled guns on me on Truslow St; no purse only cloths on - they both (Officer 1 and 2) held guns and stood on left side closest to carwash side of street. I was afraid and said nothing or don't shoot - shocked. Told me to put hands on back of my car (pictures show handprints) I did and Officer 1 put me in handcuffs and immediately into his Sheriff vehicle, I had said “why are you doing this” in so many words – he yelled “shut up and get in” or he would use violence (fact), I was in hand cuffs. I sat in Officer 1 vehicle and watched.

Watched two other sheriff cars or three arrive – then two white local police vehicles; they (cops) got out a few walked by the window (remember two faces) – they spoke to Officer 1; I heard out of Officer 1 mouth that I swore at him, I was mental and an Independent for President. He then went and opened my vehicle and ransacked it and started handing out campaign literature – he place one into in his back pocket, as he walked by his cop vehicle he opened his mouth and I heard “this is women two weeks ago came into police station” was odd/wasn't sheriff station where asked for police report.

I sat in car and watched cops engage with Officer 1 couldn't hear Officer 2 he remained in background and can't remember or be accurate who the second cop was in my car; however other cops could validate for they were also watching.

Officer 1 got into his Sheriff vehicle and I asked why are you doing this (pull data recorders) told me to "shut up" took me to Sheriff Dept. Officer 1 said as getting out of car "this is a foreigner" (odd) I am not, wasn't sure if he was being fed inaccurate information from another source? Hand cuffed whole time and in large Sheriff Dept. hand cuff area sat; no Miranda rights at any time or explanation of charges.

Officer 1 did not engage with me in Sheriff Dept. which was about 30min in length, their Officer 2 took over; Officer 1 came in once 10 ft. from me and turned and walked away. Officer 2 discussed politics of private thoughts and no mention or discussion of arrest. Officer 2 took fingers prints with machine and at prison guard took old fashion ink fingerprints.

Officer 2 discussed Brain Scan goes to FBI of private thoughts – inquired if he liked science. He spoke or taunted about all cars have a black box in car and police can pull the information to hear what person says in car. He brought up Boston and he said he would kill them, I said at Federal level they should of gone in 3 years ago as Founders would expected Civil War, etc. ok if overthrow Constitution. Pull tape basic conversation.

Drive to Judge (assume) I sat in Officer 1 vehicle and he went in to Court House; he then came out by himself and he took a duffle bag that I had not noticed sitting next to me in back seat; Officer 1 put it in his trunk. Officer 1 then went back into court building and then came out with unidentified man (judge assume) Officer 1 opened window and I said I "heard directions to approach cop and I said fuck however not to cop." Judge just stood – he turned to Officer 1 who stood in front of his vehicle and he said "FBI".

On the drive to prison – at underpass leaving Charleston – Officer 1 said don't ever approach a cop's window again (they?)will blow your head off. Sat silent – half way to prison Officer 1 on cell - car swerved he put on seat belt and then we arrived at Prison. Again he left no Miranda rights or charges ever discussed. Sat in prison overnight and left around 12 noon on Sunday.

Towing garage car was ransacked by police; money left throw in vehicle as jewelry. Campaign literature in box dumped all other back seat and hatch truck; purse empty and \$2200 cash in wallet brought to me in prison. Towing company thought odd also. Phone bill missing and American Express yet found that a bottom of inside storage unit between driver/passenger seat.
